PSA Resolution No. 07 Series of 2015

APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF PULSE ASIA RESEARCH INCORPORATED AS THE PRIVATE SECTOR REPRESENTATIVE TO THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) was established through Republic Act No. 10625 to effect necessary and proper changes in the organizational and functional structure of the Philippine Statistical System (PSS);

WHEREAS, Section 05 of RA 10625 states that the PSA shall be governed by a Board as the highest policy-making body on statistical matters;

WHEREAS, Section 07 of RA 10625 stipulates that the Board shall be composed of the following: the NEDA Director-General, as Chairperson; the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) or the duly designated Undersecretary, as Vice Chairperson; National Statistician; one (1) representative each from the other departments in the national government; a representative of the BSP; the Executive Director of the PSRTI; a representative of the Philippine Statistical Association; a representative from the GOCCs; a representative each from the Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines (ULAP) and the private sector to be appointed by the Chairperson of the PSA Board for a term of three (3) years, with reappointment, from a list of nominees submitted by the other members of the Board;

WHEREAS, the Private Sector representative shall be appointed by the PSA Board Chairperson and shall have a three-year term with possible reappointment for another three years;


WHEREAS, to complete the composition of the PSA Board and to further enhance the partnership between the private sector and the government in the generation of official statistics, the PSA hereby approves the designation of the Pulse Asia Research, Inc. as the representative of the private sector in the PSA Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves the appointment of Pulse Asia Research, Inc. as the representative of the Private Sector to the PSA Board effective 16 June 2015 to 15 June 2018;
