**PSA Board Resolution No. 02
Series of 2022**

**APPROVING THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICAL DEVELOPMENT
PROGRAM 2018-2023 UPDATE FOR ADOPTION BY THE
PHILIPPINE STATISTICAL SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 10625 or “The Philippine Statistical Act of 2013,” provides for the preparation of the Philippine Statistical Development Program (PSDP) by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA);

WHEREAS, the PSDP sets the strategic directions, thrusts and priorities of the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) in the medium term to provide vital information support to national, sectoral and local development plans, and international commitments;

WHEREAS, the PSDP provides the necessary framework for the development, generation, and dissemination of statistics and indicators needed in evidence-based policies, plans, and decisions of government and other key stakeholders and data users at the national and local levels;

WHEREAS, in May 2018, the PSS released the PSDP 2018-2023 which represents the convergence of stakeholders in the PSS towards a solid, responsive, innovative statistical system for an empowered Philippines by 2023;

WHEREAS, the PSDP 2018-2023 was formulated to address the data requirements of priority development programs set forth in the medium-term Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2017-2022, among others;

WHEREAS, the Updated PDP 2017-2022 was published with the results matrices in 2021 “to align with the country’s need for recovery and the new and better normal towards the goal of a healthy and resilient Philippines, as foundation of achieving the *AmBisyon Natin 2040*,”

WHEREAS, the National Economic and Development Authority made an assessment on the data requirements for the Updated PDP 2017-2022 Results Matrices and identified indicators that need action from the PSS;

WHEREAS, there is a need to consistently support organizational developments and address emerging information demands within and about the PSS involving the: Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs); ASEAN economic integration; the Asian and Pacific Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Decade; the Community-Based Monitoring System, and use of other sources of data (big data, citizen-generated data, administrative data, registers); data revolution; establishment of a responsive and sustainable data ecosystem; and international commitments;

WHEREAS, considering the recent developments and consistent with RA 10625's mandate for the PSDP to be responsive to the requirements of development planning and policy formulation, the PSA spearheaded the updating of the PSDP 2018-2023 in collaboration with the focal agencies, and existing interagency committees (IACs) on statistics and regional statistics committees (RSCs);

WHEREAS, the draft statistical development programs were presented to various stakeholders from government agencies and their attached bureaus and agencies, legislative offices, academe, media, civil society organizations, and other producers and users of statistics during consultative forums;

WHEREAS, the PSDP 2018-2023 Update was discussed and approved by the PSDP 2018-2023 Steering Committee during its meeting held on 18 April 2022, for endorsement to the PSA Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves the PSDP 2018-2023 Update (Annex BR 02-20220513-01) for adoption by the PSS.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Board:

- 1) enjoin all agencies in the PSS to cooperate in the implementation of the PSDP 2018-2023 Update;
- 2) enjoin all concerned agencies to include the proposed SDPs in their annual budget proposal to the Department of Budget and



Management (DBM) and to submit annual report on the status of the statistical development programs to the PSA, for presentation to the PSA Board; and

- 3) enjoin the PSA to disseminate and communicate the PSDP 2018-2023 Update to all stakeholders and to periodically monitor and evaluate its implementation.
