**PSA Board Resolution No. 19
Series of 2021**

**APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE MODIFICATION
IN THE SYSTEM OF DESIGNATED STATISTICS
INVOLVING THE SCHEDULE OF RELEASE OF VITAL STATISTICS
FROM THE CIVIL REGISTRATION SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, Executive Order (EO) No. 352 – *Designation of Statistical Activities That Will Generate Critical Data for Decision Making of the Government and the Private Sector* issued on 01 July 1996, established the System of Designated Statistics (SDS) in the Philippine Statistical System (PSS);

WHEREAS, per EO No. 352 and succeeding resolutions related to SDS, a total of 67 designated statistics and statistical activities are now being generated/implemented by 18 agencies under the PSS, as approved based on established criteria;

WHEREAS, the SDS is a dynamic process that allows continuous improvement/updating which involves modifications, addition of relevant activities, and/or deletion of activities that are no longer considered priority, to keep it attuned to the needs of data users;

WHEREAS, any modification on, addition to, or deletion from the list of designated statistics and statistical activities shall be approved by the PSA Board through a resolution in accordance with the implementing guidelines of EO No. 352 and succeeding resolutions on the modifications to the designated statistics/statistical activities;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) has proposed modifications in the schedule of release for the designated activity Generation of Vital Statistics from the Civil Registration System;

WHEREAS, the current schedule of release of vital statistics is two years after the reference year;

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide up-to-date statistics on vital events (births, marriages, and deaths) which are essential in monitoring progress and performance of the health system in the country, and serve as basis for the health programs of the Department of Health;

WHEREAS, from two years after the reference year, the schedule of release of vital statistics on births, marriages and deaths will be amended to:

- a) 11 months after the reference year for marriage statistics;
- b) 12 months after the reference year for birth statistics; and
- c) 13 months after the reference year for death statistics;

WHEREAS, the Interagency Committee on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (IACCRVS) reviewed the PSA's proposal for modification vis-à-vis the approved criteria and found it to be compliant;

WHEREAS, the IACCRVS is endorsing for approval of the Board the proposed SDS modification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board approve the modification in the SDS involving the schedule of release of vital statistics from the Civil Registration System (Annex BR 19-20211109-01), for adoption.


