Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Second Phase of June 2021

(Reference Period: 15 to 17 June 2021)

Date of Release: 09 July 2021

1. The average retail prices of a kilogram of regular milled rice increased by PhP 0.06 to PhP 0.40 in five regional centers during the second phase of June 2021 (15 to 17 June 2021), from their price levels in the first phase of the month (01 to 05 June 2021). However, its average retail price per kilogram went down in Calapan City, Cebu City, Digos City, and Butuan City. (Table 1)
2. On the average, retail prices of a kilogram of pork with bones declined by PhP 2.50 to PhP 10.00 in six regional centers during the second phase of June 2021, relative to their price levels in the first phase of the month. Meanwhile, its average retail price per kilogram picked up by PhP 5.00 in Baguio City and San Fernando City (Region 1), and by PhP 7.50 in Tacloban City during the period. (Table 2)
3. Changes in the average retail prices of a kilogram of galunggong between the second phase and first phase of June 2021, ranging from PhP 2.00 to PhP 20.00, were noted in 11 regional centers. (Table 3)
4. Vegetables at the retail trade were generally priced higher in many regional centers during the second phase of June 2021. (Table 4)
5. Increments in the average retail prices of a kilogram of red onion, ranging from PhP 2.89 to PhP 15.00, were observed in five regional centers during the period, compared with their price levels in the first phase of June 2021. On the other hand, its average retail price per kilogram dropped by PhP 10.00 in Legazpi City during the second phase of June 2021. (Table 5)

6. Upticks in the average retail prices of a kilogram of carabao mango, ranging from PhP 5.00 to PhP 45.00, were recorded in six regional centers during the second phase of June 2021, from their price levels in the first phase of the month. Meanwhile, its average retail price per kilogram was lower by PhP 1.71 to PhP 27.50 in four regional centers during the period. (Table 6)
7. The price of a kilogram of brown sugar rose by PhP 0.20 in Kidapawan City, PhP 0.50 in Pagadian City, and PhP 1.50 in Calapan City during the second phase of June 2021. On the contrary, compared with the first phase of June 2021, the price of a kilogram of brown sugar decreased in Tuguegarao City, Legazpi City, and Butuan City during the second phase of June 2021.
