Personal services for wellness, except sports activities industry posted the highest in terms of number of establishments

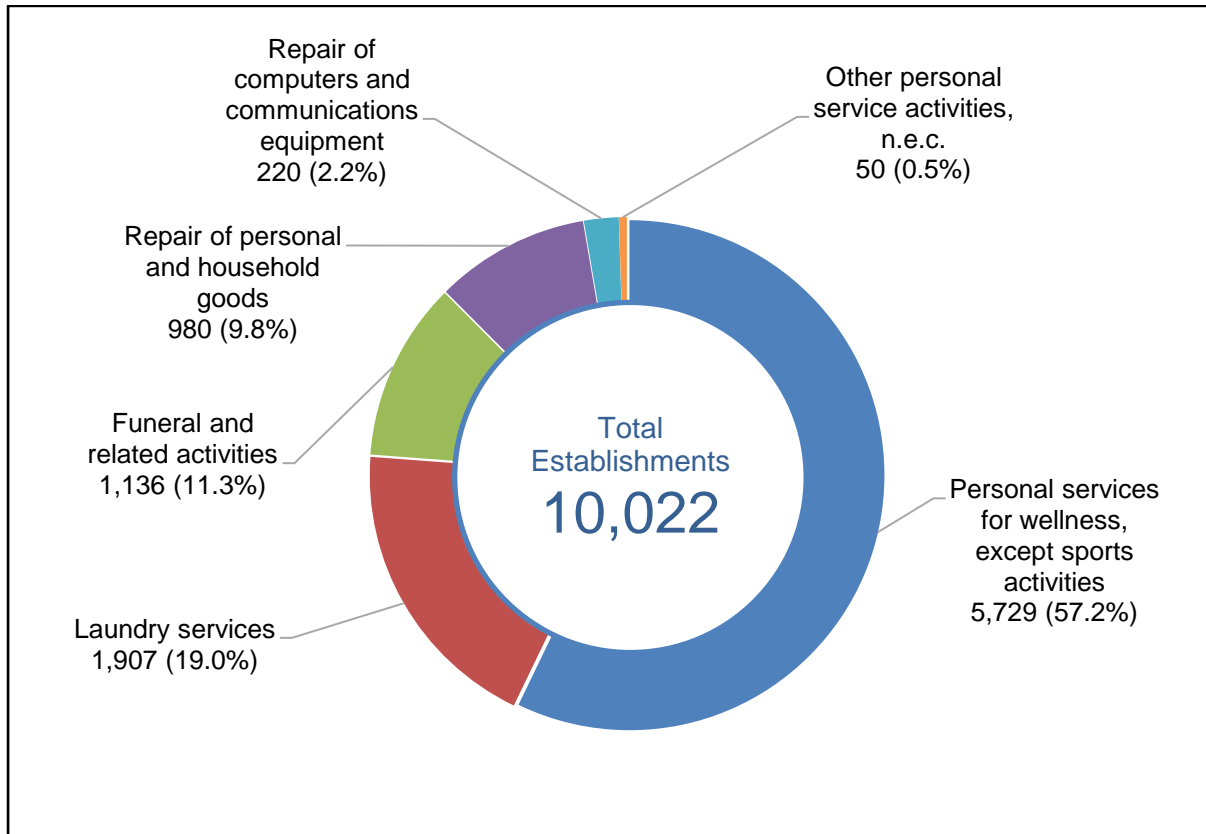
The preliminary results of the Annual Survey of Philippine Business and Industry (ASPBI) showed that a total of 10,022 establishments in the formal sector of the economy were engaged in other service activities in 2019. (Tables A and 1, Figure 1)

Among the industries, personal services for wellness, except sports activities had the highest number of 5,729 establishments (57.2%). Laundry services activities ranked second with 1,907 establishments (19.0%), while funeral and related activities ranked third with 1,136 establishments (11.3%). On the other hand, other personal



service activities, n.e.c. recorded the least number of establishments of 50 (0.5%). (Table 1 and Figure 1)

Figure 1. Percentage Distribution of Other Service Activities Sector by Industry Group: Philippines, 2019



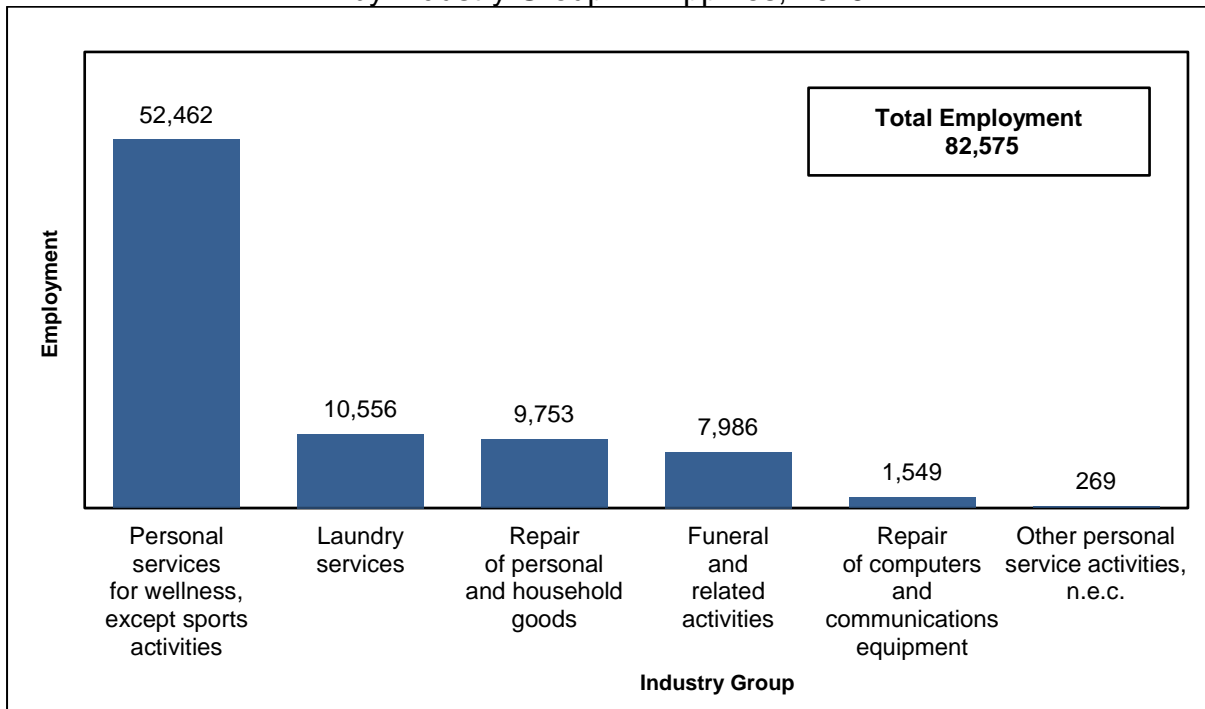

Personal services for wellness, except sports activities industry employed the highest number of workers

The sector employed a total of 82,575 of workers in 2019. Of the total, 80,179 (97.1%) were paid employees, while the rest were working owners and unpaid workers. (Table 1)

By industry group, personal services for wellness, except sports activities employed the highest number of workers of 52,462 (63.5%).x This was followed by laundry services activities with 10,556 workers (12.8%) and repair of personal and household goods with 9,753 workers (11.8%). (Table 1 and Figure 2)

The average number of workers for the sector was recorded at 8 workers per establishment in 2019. (Tables A and 2)

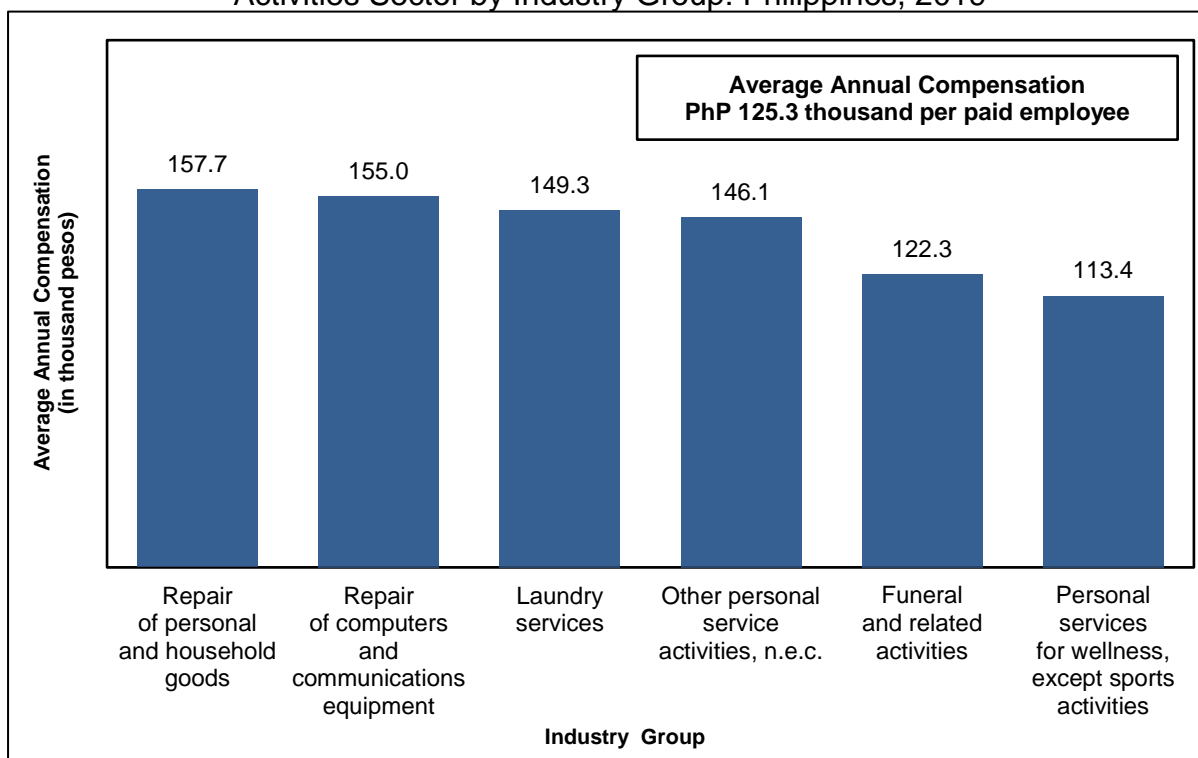
Among industry groups, repair of personal and household goods activities posted the highest average of 10 workers per establishment, followed by personal services for wellness, except sports activities with an average of nine workers per establishment. (Table 2)

Repair of personal and household goods activities industry paid the highest average annual compensation

In 2019, the total compensation paid to employees of the sector amounted to PhP 10.04 billion translating to an average annual compensation of PhP 125.28 thousand per paid employee. (Tables A and 2, Figure 3)

Among the industries, repair of personal and household goods activities paid the highest average annual compensation of PhP 157.72 thousand per paid employee. This was followed by repair of computers and communication equipment activities, and laundry services activities paying an average annual compensation of PhP 154.98 thousand and PhP 149.25 thousand per paid employee, respectively. 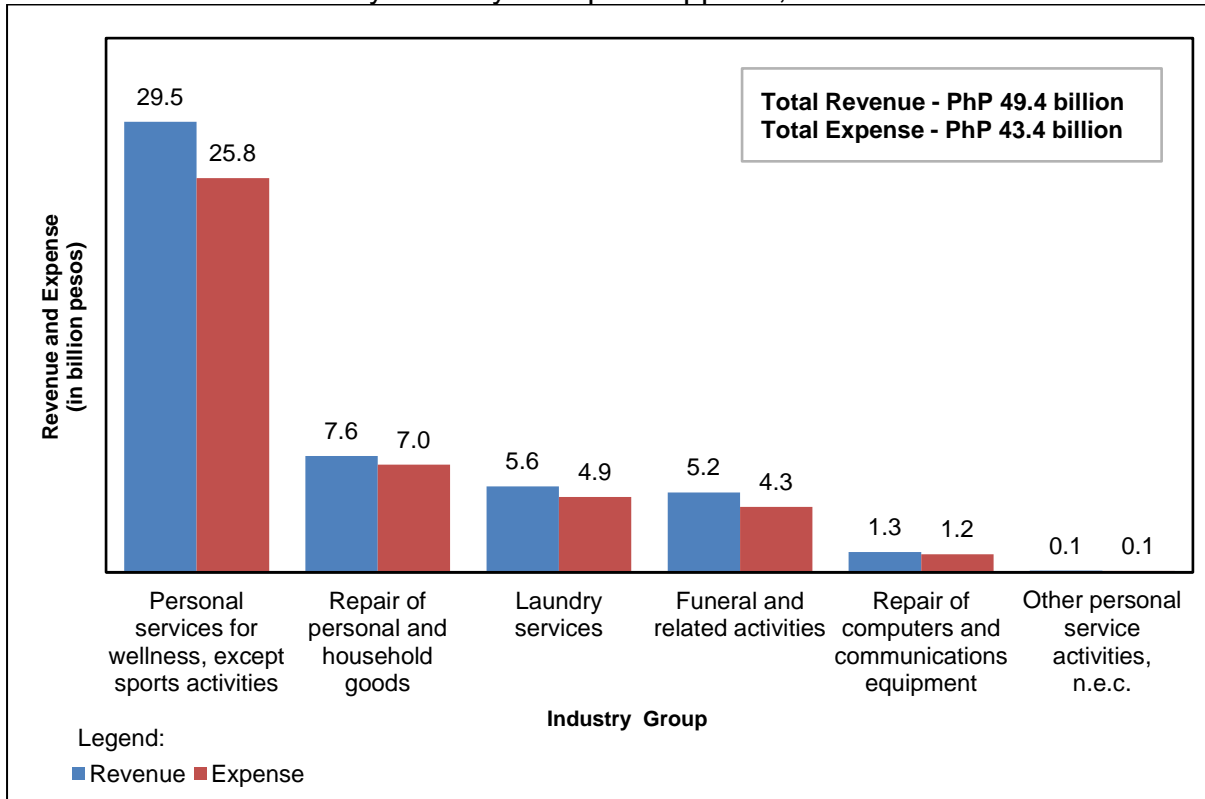
Personal services for wellness, except sports activities industry contributed the biggest share to total revenue and expense

The gross revenue earned and expense incurred by the sector in 2019 amounted to PhP 49.43 billion and PhP 43.37 billion, respectively. (Tables A and 1, and Figure 4)

The three industry groups with the highest revenue and expense were the following:

- Personal services for wellness, except sports activities with revenue of PhP 29.51 billion (59.7%) and expense of PhP 25.84 billion (59.6%);
- Repair of personal and household goods activities with PhP 7.62 billion (15.4%) revenue and expense of PhP 7.04 billion (16.2%); and
- Laundry services activities with PhP 5.63 billion (11.4%) and PhP 4.94 billion (11.4%) revenue and expense, respectively. (Table 1 and Figure 4)

The revenue generated per peso expense by the sector stood at 1.14 in 2019.

By industry group, other personal service activities, n.e.c. generated a revenue per peso expense ratio of 1.29. Funeral and related services followed with a ratio of 1.22, while repair of personal and household goods service activities recorded the lowest ratio of 1.08. (Table 2)

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
