Restaurants and mobile food service activities industry group was the highest in number of establishments

The preliminary results of the Annual Survey of Philippine Business and Industry (ASPBI) showed that a total of 34,248 establishments in the formal sector of the economy were engaged in accommodation and food service activities in 2019. (Tables A and 1)

By industry group, restaurants and mobile food service activities shared the highest number of establishments with 25,424 or 74.2 percent of the total. This was followed by short term accommodation activities with



5,119 establishments (14.9%) and beverage serving activities with 2,497 establishments (7.3%). On the other hand, other accommodation industry group recorded the least number of establishments of 550 (1.6%). (Table 1 and Figure 1)

Restaurants and mobile food service activities industry group employed the highest number of workers

The total number of workers hired by the sector reached 611,271 in 2019. Of the total, 594,080 employees (97.2%) were paid employees, while the remaining were working owners and unpaid workers. (Tables A and 1)




Figure 2. Distribution of Employment for Accommodation and Food Service Activities Sector by Industry Group: Philippines, 2019

Among the industry groups, restaurants and mobile food service activities employed the highest number with 398,524 workers (65.2%). Short term accommodation activities followed with 162,372 workers (26.6%). Beverage serving activities came in third with 30,935 workers (5.1%). (Table 1 and Figure 2)

The average number of workers for the sector was recorded at 18 workers per establishment. (Tables A and 2)

Industry-wise, short term accommodation activities posted the highest average of 32 workers per establishment, followed by event catering and other food service activities with an average of 24 workers per establishment. (Table 2)

Short term accommodation activities industry group paid the highest average annual compensation

The sector paid a total compensation of PhP 108.31 billion to its employees in 2019. This translates to an average annual compensation of PhP 182.32 thousand per paid employee. (Tables A, 1, and 2)

Among the industries, short term accommodation activities paid the highest average annual compensation of PhP 199.64 thousand per paid employee. This was followed by restaurants and mobile food service activities and event catering and other food service activities

which paid PhP 177.33 thousand and PhP 170.81 thousand per paid employee, respectively. (Table 2 and Figure 3)

Restaurants and mobile food service activities industry group contributed the biggest share to total revenue and expense




Figure 4. Revenue and Expense for Accommodation and Food Service Activities Sector by Industry Group: Philippines, 2019

The sector generated a total revenue of PhP 918.01 billion and incurred a total expense of PhP 751.80 billion in 2019. (Tables A and 1, Figure 4)

The top three industry groups in terms of revenue and expense for the sector were as follows:

- Restaurants and mobile food service activities accounted for the highest share of total revenue and total expense amounting to PhP 643.79 billion (70.1%) and PhP 534.82 billion (71.1%), respectively;
- 2. Short term accommodation activities with PhP 218.30 billion (23.8%) revenue and expense of PhP 169.01 billion (22.5%); and
- 3. Beverage serving activities with PhP 34.54 billion (3.8%) revenue and PhP 29.88 billion expense (4.0%). (Table 1 and Figure 4)

The revenue generated per peso expense by the sector stood at 1.22 in 2019. (Tables A and 2)

Among the industries, short term accommodation activities recorded the highest revenue per peso expense of 1.29. Beverage serving activities had the lowest at 1.16. (Table 2)
